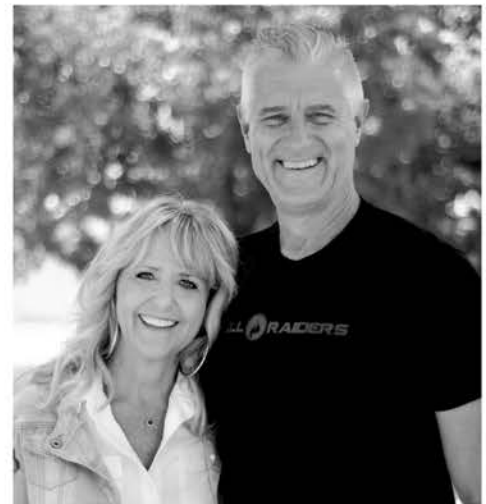

MVC HISTORY



Mountain View Church Launch

In 1994 public services began at Clovis High School with 324 in attendance at the first service! Within a few weeks, the congregation had settled at 144.



MVC Main Campus New Location

During the early 2000s, \$886,000 was raised to buy the property for a church facility, and over the course of five years, the church went back and forth with the local city and county officials in an attempt to get approval to build.



The facility development process culminated in 2005 with the sale of a 17-acre piece of property at a profit of almost \$2,000,000 and the purchase of an existing church just 2.5 miles south of our Clovis location but within the city limits of Fresno. The facility dated from the 1980s and offered 48,000 square feet of space on 15 acres for \$3,000,000. Through God's miraculous answers to prayer, we were able to purchase the facility, renovate, and move in within just a few short months.

MVC HISTORY



MVC Sunnyside Campus New Location

In 2012 we launched a satellite campus in a neighborhood several miles to the south called "Sunnyside." In 2018 we purchased a church facility on Kings Canyon just east of Fowler Ave. It is now home to our Sunnyside campus and our Spanish-language church plant, Centro Cristiano a la Naciones.



MVC East Campus

During 2021-in the middle of the Covid-we launched a new church in Old Town Clovis (Rock Harbor) and established our East campus at Reyburn Intermediate school.

GOD'S GENEROSITY 2023

WHAT'S THE VISION OF NEXTUP?

MOUNTAIN VIEW CAMPUS - \$3,019,700

1 PROPERTY - \$2,154,700

We are miraculously in escrow to purchase 9.91 acres on the south east side of our current property. This will allow us to have multiple sports fields to reach and bless our community.

2 SOLAR - \$465,000

We are installing a solar system in our back parking lot that will pay for itself in the next few years and eliminate our electrical bill.

3 IMPROVEMENTS - \$400,000

We are excited to put HVAC in the Hub, repair the parking lot, and update our landscaping to improve our curb appeal, which will bless our neighborhood. We will repair and renew areas inside the building and complete various smaller projects.

SUNNYSIDE CAMPUS - \$180,000

We are installing solar at the Sunnyside campus, hiring staff, completing various smaller projects and giving a tithe to missions.

EAST CAMPUS - \$90,000

We are putting money aside for a building, hiring staff and giving to a tithe for missions.

MISSIONS - \$130,000

We are excited to tithe as a church-give 10%-of pledges received from the MVC family, so that the world will hear the Gospel.

CAN MOUNTAIN VIEW RAISE \$1,000,000+ BEYOND ITS ANNUAL BUDGET?

We believe that \$1,000,000 is an attainable goal. We are working closely with a stewardship consultant and we have seen the generosity of the Mountain View family demonstrated again and again over the years. It will certainly be a challenge to meet this goal, but we believe that if the whole church family participates, we will meet and exceed it.

HAVE WE SECURED A LOAN FOR \$1,000,000?

Yes, the Mennonite Brethren Foundation has approved our loan application for up to \$2,900,000 and will assist us in the purchase of the land, once escrow closes.

HOW WILL WE RAISE \$1,000,000 OUTSIDE MOUNTAIN VIEW?

Pastor Fred has relationships with various “friends of Mountain View” who enjoy giving to ministry that expands the Kingdom of God. His is confident that the Lord will provide through their generosity.

WHAT DO YOU MEAN BY “UNEXPECTED MIRACLES”?

We anticipate that the Lord will provide in-kind donations, or unexpected price discounts or gifts from unexpected individuals/organizations.

WILL GIVING TO NEXTUP HAVE A NEGATIVE EFFECT ON FUNDING REGULAR CHURCH MINISTRY?

No, we do not expect to see an adverse effect. In fact, we expect that as many people begin tithing for the first time, giving to the regular ministry of the church will increase.

WILL GIVING TO NEXTUP HAVE A NEGATIVE EFFECT ON FUNDING GLOBAL MISSIONS?

No, we remain committed to funding global missions. In fact, we are committed to tithing on the pledges we receive and investing them in our missions projects around the world.

FAQ'S

WHY DO WE NEED TO BUY MORE LAND?

Developers were attempting to build homes right along our southern back fence, putting neighborhood back yards and bedroom windows with 60 feet our Sanctuary. This would be a problem for us.

This 10 acre piece would give us access to Dakota Ave. and open the door to a wide variety of developmental options in the future.

WHY DON'T WE JUST SELL THE 20 ACRES WE OWN ON BULLARD AVE?

Our property on Bullard Ave. is still a wonderful location for a church plant or campus, and we continue to pray that this miracle will happen. It has appreciated in value, to be sure, but it remains designated as agricultural land and has not been incorporated into the city of Clovis. When it is incorporated, the property will skyrocket in value and provide us with many development options. In the meantime, it remains as a God-given emergency fund.

WHAT DO WE HOPE TO ACHIEVE BY INSTALLING SOLAR?

We expect that we will be able to pay off our solar investment within 10 years using PG&E bill savings. After that, we will be able to invest the savings in to ministry for years to come.

WHERE ARE WE IN THE PROCESS OF PURCHASING THE LAND?

We expect to close escrow shortly. We are waiting for the city to confirm the exact lot lines of the property.

HOW SOON CAN WE EXPECT TO SEE FIELDS INSTALLED?

Our first step will be to put up a block wall to satisfy the seller. We will then begin the work of preparing the ground and planting.

CAN I PLAN MY GIVING SCHEDULE MYSELF?

Absolutely. Our goal is to see the pledges completed between December 2023 and January 2025. How and when the pledges come in are up to each giver.

HOW TO MAKE A PLEDGE*

What difference can my financial commitment to NextUp make in my heart and life? How might my gift change me and allow me to invest myself more meaningfully in this vision for Mountain View Church, our community and our world?

Am I willing to pray for God's guidance in how He might want to work through me in the gospel movement in Fresno and Clovis and beyond?

Am I thinking in a way that is easy and effortless, or challenging and requiring more discipline to be selfless in response to this vision?

What things can I afford, but am intentionally choosing to live without because I am committing to give sacrificially? Can I order my financial priorities to better reflect the order of what I really love?

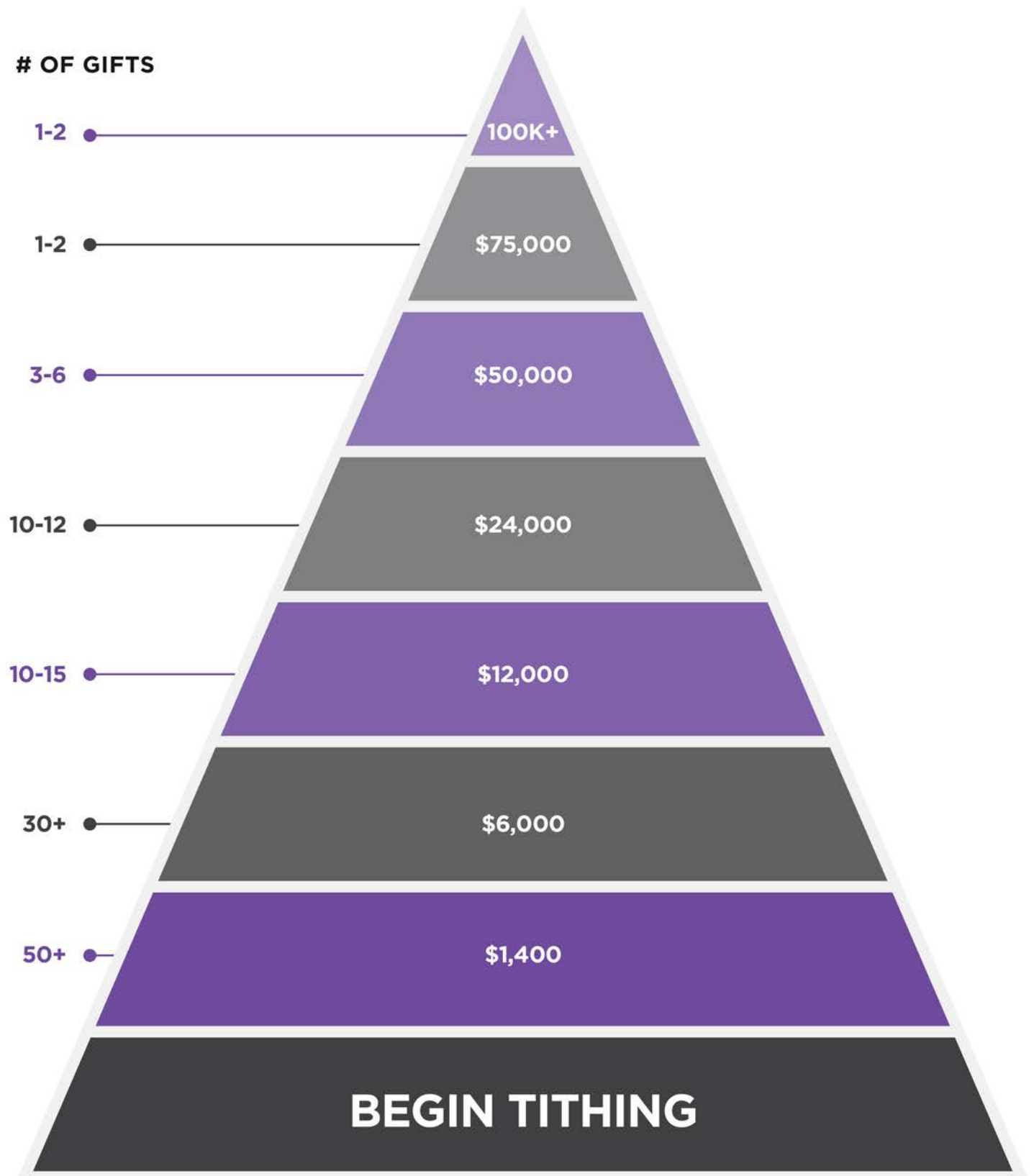

SHAPE explained

S] SCRIPTURE:

Start by finding the sections of the Bible for the day and read them. Mark in your Bible, highlight, underline or star the verses that speak to you. Then write out one or two of them in your journal.

H] HEAR:

Next, take time to hear from God what He has to say to you about this verse or verses. Write down what you believe the Lord is speaking to your heart. Write it out in the voice of God. The Bible it is God's divine word and we expect God to speak to us.

A] APPLY:

Now we move to the part that causes the rubber to meet the road. We apply what we have read and heard.

P] PRAYER:

It is good to seal this commitment in prayer to God. Take some time to write out a prayer to God of what is on your heart. Ask God to help you, encourage you and strengthen you to follow through on your commitments and desires for the day.

E] EXALT:

We want to take time each day to praise God and to be thankful for the blessings we have received. There is so much to be grateful for in our lives!
